	accommodation, and ensures that refuge provision will	
	continue to be available in the city. • Staffing - this relates	
	to the maximisation of legitimate funding for	
	administration and management costs in areas where the	
	commissioning service has attracted additional funding for	
	the Council, and/or is managing external ringfenced grants	
	on behalf of the Council and/or is carrying out functions on	
	behalf of partners such as the NHS. It is a continuation of	
	an existing approach which has successfully delivered	
	underspends on the team's general fund staffing budget. It	
	does not involve a reduction in staffing. There is a risk	
	relating to the non-continuation or reduction of	
	government grants. However, the relevant grants relate to	
	government priorities and/or statutory duties and are	
	considered likely to continue.

There is a risk relating to the non-continuation of the relevant grants, although this risk is considered small as the grants relate to government priorities and/or statutory duties. This will be monitored through regular financial monitoring arrangements. Current services and support will continue for all citizens with protected characteristics. The services in scope are accessible by groups regardless of any protected characteristics. Some contracts offer gender specific services to address an identified and/or assessed need. This EIA has not identified any adverse impact as a result of the replacement of existing funding with external grant funding, as this will allow the continuation of existing services and support. There is a future risk relating to the non-continuation or reduction of government grants. This will be monitored through regular financial management arrangements. However, the relevant grants relate to government priorities and/or statutory duties and are considered likely to continue.
