Brief description of the policy, service or function covered by the EIA	Bulky waste collections have been chargeable since 2013 and in 22/23 has brought in more income than expected. The service currently has a pricing model of £35.70 for a bulky waste collection which can include up to 10 items which will increase to £45. Vulnerable citizens receiving an assisted collection are entitled to one free bulky waste collection per year. Collections are made by two separate vehicles, one being open back allowing for compaction of the bulky items and the other with tail lift allowing for collection of white goods and all other types of WEEE (Waste Electrical & Electronic Equipment). This allows all WEE to be recycled. The single charge can be a combination of any types of items. This service helps keep Birmingham as clean as possible by providing a cost- effective collection service to citizens, especially where they do not have transport to visit one of the five household recycling sites.
